## **3. Eligibility:**

- Only Punjab residents can participate.
- Rated/ Non Rated players can Participate.
- U15 category: Players should be born on or after 1.1.2004 .for U07 category :-Players should be born on or after 1.1.2012 .

It will be conducted separately, for open and girls. Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age. Certificates from school are not enough. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation registered within one year of birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate.

#### **4. Entry Fee:**

**For U07 AND U15 == Rs. 400/-**

**Entry fee will be accepted strictly through NEFT/IMPS/RTGS only.**

- 7. Time Control: 45 Minutes + 15 Second increment per move, starting from move no. 01.**

## **8. Tie Break:**

Following is the order of tie-break:

1. Direct encounter
2. Buchholz Cut 1
3. Buchholz
4. Sonneborn Berger
5. The greater number of wins (forfeits included) In case of tie, prizes will not be shared

**9. Protest:** Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1,000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

**10. Appeals Committee:** Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member appeals committee shall be formed by Organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from different states. No member of the U07 & U15 Committee can vote on a dispute in which a player from his own State is involved and in such case(s) the reserve member(s) shall take his place in the committee.

**11. PSCA Registration:** Participants must be registered with PSCA for the year 2019-20. New players must pay an

amount of Rs.150/- towards PSCA registration fee along with the duly filled and signed PSCA player's registration form plus one passport size photograph along with Birth Certificate copy.

**12. Lodging:** Lodging will be provided to only out station players.

**13. Selection for National:** Top Two players selected from each category will represent Punjab state in upcoming “National U07 & U15 Open & Girls Chess Championship” .Selected Players should inform to PSCA by mail within seven days after completion of the selection state tournaments for their participation in Nationals. After above said days no request will be entertained.
